enway publishes Whitepaper on Blockchain

The paper explains in a transparent manner how distributed ledger technology is efficiently employed in the energy sector.

Hamburg, 17. June 2019 – enway, an online market place for direct energy, has published a whitepaper on blockchain. Using current use cases as an example, the paper shows how the technology is employed at enway.

The first active use case is “asset sharing“, featured in the company’s product „change“. The goal of the product is to realize a large solar plant together with many people. Different parts of the solar plant are allocated tamper-proof to the respective customers via blockchain. As a basis for this, a blockchain ecosystem has been created, which comprises a multi-token model and a register for digital identities. Further use cases can be developed based on this system. These can include, among other things, crowd-investing at national and inter-national levels, a plant-specific proof of origin, the merger of a self-sufficient power community and eventually the fully automated, high-frequency electricity trade between people.

„Many people talk about blockchain. But we actually employ the technology in concrete use cases and generate real value for our customers“, explains Andreas Rieckhoff, CTO and co-founder of enway. „We show that applying blockchain technology already makes sense today. We want to pave the way so that politics will create better regulatory frameworks to enable Germany to take a leading role in this sphere.“
